



2022 Senior Student Scholarship Program – General Information

Dear Educator/Student:

Since 1965, each year in the spring, the Desert Art Center has awarded several scholarships to high school seniors. These scholarships help provide financial assistance for their pursuit of an art or design related degree at an art school, college, or university of their choosing. 2022 Scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each will be awarded to 3-5 successful candidates at the DAC's discretion.

The Desert Art Center of Coachella Valley is now soliciting applications from **high school seniors**, and **prior recipients** from 2020/21, for the annual scholarship awards program. Eligible candidates must be continuing their art or design education by enrolling in a visual arts program in a university, college, community college or art school.

Students must submit the following electronically.

1. Completed application form
2. Brief statement about themselves, their educational goals
3. Minimum of three pieces of their artwork (high resolution pdf/jpeg format)
4. Letter of recommendation from their art teacher

Please Note;

All artwork must be ready for hanging and 3D work show ready.
Any medium is acceptable including three-dimensional work and clay.
Label all artwork with student name, school, and title.
Successful applicants will be notified by phone, email and a follow up letter.
